1. Introduction

1.1 Purpose. This Cookie Policy explains how Hoonify Technologies Inc., a corporation with offices at 13170 Central Ave SE, Ste B #435, Albuquerque, NM 87123 (“Hoonify,” “we,” “us,” or “our”), uses cookies and similar technologies on hoonify.ai and the related web console, dashboards, and other web-based properties (collectively, the “Website”).

1.2 Relationship to Other Policies. This Cookie Policy supplements, and should be read together with, the Hoonify Privacy Policy and the Hoonify Terms and Conditions. Where this Cookie Policy describes the processing of personal data, the Privacy Policy governs how we handle that data. Capitalized terms not defined here have the meaning given in the Terms.

1.3 Scope. This Cookie Policy applies to our Website. It does not apply to inference requests submitted to the Hoonify API, which are governed by the Terms and the Data Protection Agreement and are processed on a zero-data-retention basis. We do not use cookies to read or store the contents of your prompts or Output.

2. What Are Cookies?

2.1 Cookies. A cookie is a small text file that a website stores on your device when you visit. Cookies allow the website to recognize your device, remember your preferences and actions over time, keep you signed in, and understand how the Website is used.

2.2 Similar Technologies. We also use technologies that function like cookies, including local storage, session storage, software development kit (SDK) identifiers, pixels, tags, and similar mechanisms. In this Cookie Policy, references to “cookies” include these similar technologies.

2.3 First- and Third-Party Cookies. “First-party cookies” are set by Hoonify. “Third-party cookies” are set by a service provider or partner on our behalf, for example to provide authentication, analytics, or security. Section 4 describes the third parties we use.

2.4 Session and Persistent Cookies. “Session cookies” are temporary and are deleted when you close your browser. “Persistent cookies” remain on your device until they expire or you delete them.

3. Categories of Cookies We Use

3.1 Essential vs. Optional. Strictly necessary cookies are required to operate the Website and are set without your consent where permitted by law. All other categories are optional and, where required by law, are set only with your consent.

4. Third-Party Cookies and Service Providers

4.1 Providers. Some cookies are set by third parties that provide services to us, such as identity and authentication providers, product analytics, error monitoring, and content delivery and security providers. These providers may process limited information (such as IP address and device or browser data) to deliver their services. 7.1 Updates. We may update this Cookie Policy from time to time to reflect changes in the cookies we use or for operational, legal, or regulatory reasons. We will post the revised version with an updated effective date and, where required, seek renewed consent. Continued use of the Website after the effective date constitutes acceptance of the updated policy.
